MIDDLE TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL

Middle Township High School is a four-year, accredited, comprehensive high school situated in central Cape May County. The school serves the communities of Middle Township, Dennis Township, Avalon, Woodbine and Stone Harbor. Middle Township consists of approximately 70 square miles of rural, lightly populated woodlands and marshes. Within the borders of the township are small-unincorporated villages including the county seat, Cape May Court House. Dennis Township is similar to Middle Township, but is slightly smaller geographically and in population. Avalon and Stone Harbor are seashore resorts located on Seven-Mile Island. Seasonal tourist trade is the major economic factor for the area. Middle Township High School serves approximately 850 students with ninety faculty members.

Middle Township High School is committed to offering our students numerous educational opportunities. By offering a college and career readiness curriculum, we hope to engage students in the classroom and raise their expectations for post —secondary plans. In addition to meeting the new state graduation requirements, we offer 13 Advanced Placement courses and 14 dual credit courses with Atlantic Cape Community College. Both of these options afford our students the opportunity to earn college credit before graduation. Our concurrent enrollment program similarly allows our students the opportunity to receive both high school credit and college credit by attending classes at Atlantic Cape Community College while they are still in high school.
