OPPORTUNITIES


What are your goals? Are demands shifting? How can it be improved?

Some respondents selected more than one group




Strengths: What Our Community Values Most

Areas for Improvement: Meeting Challenges Head-on

- More Classroom Support for teachers
- Better system for onboarding families to district and schools
- Updated technology; enhanced Wi-Fi connectivity
- HVAC upgrades for classroom comfort and focus
- Competitive compensation for staff

Opportunities for Growth: Preparing Students for the Future

- Increase student **mental health and wellness support** especially with victims of Bullying
- Preschool expansion for growing population
- Expand career and vocational training opportunities with local partnerships
- More **life skills courses** (financial literacy, auto care, home ec) and strengthen tech courses, including robotics and coding
- Relevant Curriculum and teacher support with implementation
- Increase selection of **rigorous electives** across subject areas

Community Connections: Strengthening Engagement

- Improve **communication channels** and provide consistent updates
- Encourage more **family involvement** in events and advisory groups
- Host more **community-building events** (game nights, cultural celebrations)
- Offer parent education and support workshops
- Re-establish **PTO/PTA** to enhance collaboration



External Challenges: Factors Impacting Our Schools

- Funding & Budget: Limited state support for facility needs
- Rapid Community Growth: Increased class sizes, need for more staff
- Student Well-Being: Impact of social media; mental health needs
- Economic Hardships: Lack of affordable housing, childcare (56.83% F/R Lunch 25-26)
- **Space:** Room for the district to grow


